The grand launch of Parkson Maju Junction Shopping Mall was graced by Parkson Group Chairman and Managing Director, Tan Sri William Cheng; Maju Holdings Sdn Bhd (MHSB) Director, Mohd Faiq Abu Said; MHSB Deputy Group Executive Chairman, Datuk Seri Mohd Fauzi Yon; MHSB Group CEO, Ir Seth Lim Sow Wu; Parkson Maju Junction Centre Manager, Encik Ruslan Haji Naim and senior management of Parkson on 19 January 2016.

In his welcome speech at the launch, Tan Sri William Cheng said, "It is our first fully-managed mall in Malaysia, encompassing shopping, dining and lifestyle under one roof."

Parkson as the anchor tenant occupies 9,290 square metres of retail space over three floors and offers a diverse range

of products from fashion to home furnishing, electrical, electronics and household products. Two other major tenants, Foodpark by Parkson and Little Kingdom mark the company's first foray into a gourmet-concept supermarket and food hall as well as an edutainment outlet for children.

Foodpark by Parkson combines grocery shopping and dining, and is inspired by concepts adopted from overseas whilst Little Kingdom, occupying more than 3,716 sq metres over two floors is an adventure and exploration outlet for children, with games and puzzle maze to be enjoyed together with parents.

The mall has 26 other tenants which include restaurants, cafes and service outlets for a comprehensive shopping experience.

ion-Parkson Tsinghua Calligraphy Competition 2016 by Lion-Parkson Foundation (LPF), Tsinghua University from Beijing, China and Universiti Tunku Abdul Rahman (UTAR) was held at UTAR Campus in Bandar Sungai Long, Selangor on 10 January 2016. 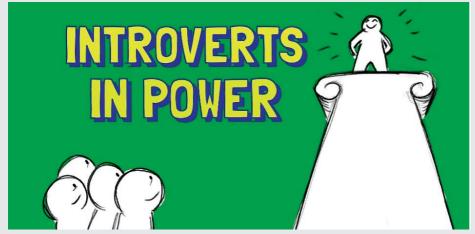

1. Good Leaders Treat Those Around Them As Individuals

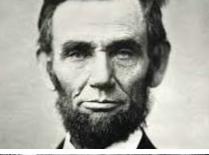

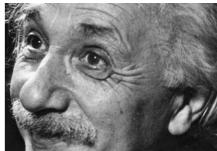


Questions that lead to better leadership practice:

They follow through on commitments. They have strong characters and are consistent in their beliefs. They offer to help for the good of the team. Introverts can practice this aspect of leadership by knowing their values and contributing to a positive overall environment.



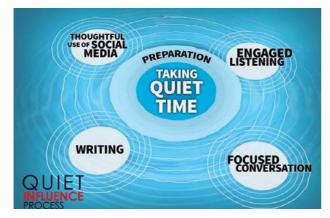
Questions that lead to better leadership practice:

Questions that lead to better leadership practice:

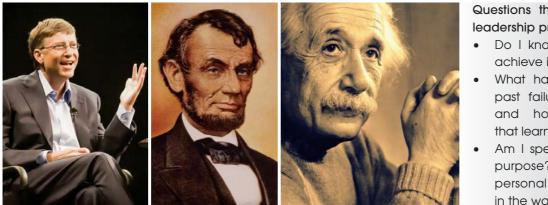
- Do I understand how my work and that of my colleagues connects the purpose of the organisation and can I communicate that to others?

5. Good Leaders Are Both Strong-Willed And Humble



They are driven to achieve a purpose, but aren't interested in taking all the credit or blaming others for failure. They are strong yet reflective.
